WIVEC is a project of Wisconsin Faith Voices for Justice. Its purpose is to increase ties among different faith communities in the work of furthering democracy and equity in our state and nation. WIVEC works with clergy and lay leaders to promote educational and equity-based actions.

WIVEC, with the help of our many state-wide partners, has been at the center of the non-partisan work of ensuring voter rights and freedom. We have hosted statewide webinars led by experts in their fields, organized canvassing campaigns across the state, registered voters at local events and in high schools, provided postcards to congregations and other organizations, organized our signature Poll Chaplain program, and joined in many other actions and events to further the cause of democracy.

Job Description:

Crucial to growing our capacity is the ability to have local organizers around the state who can do outreach and recruitment, make personal connections, organize local events, and build a strong statewide network. We would like to expand to Green Bay, the Fox Valley, Eau Claire, LaCrosse, Beloit, and other areas of the state. With central staff and state-wide organizers, we can continue to build successful partnerships beyond the Madison and Milwaukee communities.

The goal of our organizer will be to activate, train, and support clergy, lay leaders, and congregants to run various voter engagement actions. These actions can include but are not limited to door to door canvassing, voter registration drives, congregational postcarding events, relational text banking, and data collection.

Is this you? The Organizer will:

- Contact, build relationships, and work alongside local partner organizations and congregations.
- Work alongside key lay and clergy leaders to plan the logistics for kick off and other local voter engagement actions.

- Provide ongoing support, coaching, and follow up to ensure successful execution and post-drive reporting.
- Maintain reporting on voter registration drives.
- Perform other duties and projects as assigned.

- Lives in one of our targeted regions
- Excellent oral and written communication skills, including great interpersonal skills and ability to gain the trust of and to inspire others.
- Organization and attention to detail, creativity, and judgment.
- Experience in organizing, outreach, and advocacy is a plus
- Comfortable working across different faith traditions

- The Organizers report to the Program Lead and Interfaith State-wide Organizer.
- Must be willing to attend meetings and various actions during the day as well as in the late afternoons and occasional events on evenings and weekends.
- Must have transportation.
